

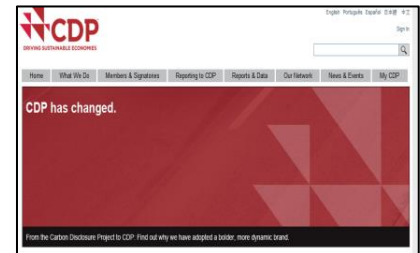
Two Sides Reference Sheet

Environmental Reporting

Two Sides supports sustainability reporting. Organizations should aim for open and transparent environmental reporting. In addition to annual environmental or sustainability reports, it is recommended that companies consider voluntary reporting to outside organizations to participate in industry benchmarking and ranking. Below are some examples of resources and tools related to environmental reporting.

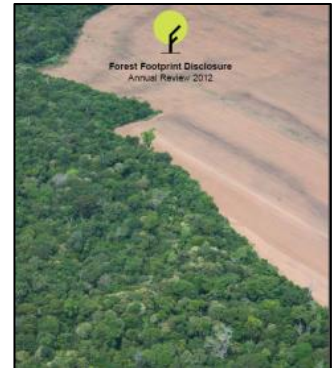
[CDP \(formerly the Carbon Disclosure Project\)](#)

CDP is an international, not-for-profit organization providing the only global system for companies and cities to measure, disclose, manage and share vital environmental information. CDP works with market forces to motivate companies to disclose their impacts on the environment and natural resources and take action to reduce them.



[CDP Forests Program \(Formerly the Forest Disclosure Project\)](#)

The CDP Forests Program, formerly the Forest Footprint Disclosure Project engages with private sector companies to ask them to disclose their current understanding of their 'forest footprint' based on exposure to five key commodities – soy, palm oil, timber, cattle products and biofuels – in their operations and/or supply chains. An Annual Review describes the findings of the Disclosure Request based on the responses of participating companies and provides some context on the current issues and concerns surrounding forest risk commodities.
